From October 2002 to September 2008 she was a member of the German Bundestag. She was also Minister of State to the German Chancellor from November 2005 to September 2008.

From May 2016, she was a member of the board of innogy SE and was responsible for the network & infrastructure department as well as the coordination of digitalization projects.
